- 2.2 the period of your availability, include start and end dates. (This should be 5 months or longer)
- * Incomplete applications will not be considered. (A cloud-based online application will be made available soon where documents can also be uploaded.)
- Periods & capacity: We accept volunteers for periods 5 months and longer, due to the nature of our work. We do ongoing capacity planning, as volunteers come and go.
- <u>Selection & placement</u>: An initial selection and interview process applies, followed by a written volunteer acceptance (should your application be successful).
 - **Should you be selected** as a potentially suitable candidate for a specific programme, the HR Manager will do an introduction between that programme manager and yourself, who will then conduct a **virtual interview** with you.
- Timeline expectations: Please allow time for this application process, as programme managers are extremely busy with day-to-day operations of their programmes. We will do our best to provide you with feedback on your application within 30 days of receiving a complete application. If you do not hear from us within 30 days of sending your complete application, please consider your application as unsuccessful. Reasons may include: that we do not have an opening during the period of your availability, so please do not take it personally. ©
